Registration Information

Teams register online at EdinaMN.gov/parks. Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Deadline to register is Nov. 5, 2020.

League Information

Teams will play ten games. The league will have a single elimination playoff. Games are played on Wednesday nights and refereed by paid officials. League begins on Nov. 18, 2020. Weather information is updated on EdinaParks.com. Schedules and weekly standings will be posted on the City of Edina Parks & Recreation website. League champions will receive championship t-shirt. Edina resident teams made up of 90% Edina residents receive a resident discount.

Location

- South View Middle School, 4725 South View Lane, Edina; park in the Green lot and enter Door #10, SV Gym #3 is located down the hallway past the theater.
- Edina Community Center, 5701 Normandale Rd, Edina: park in the Gold lot and enter Door #8. ECC City Gym is a left down the first hallway.
- Edina High School Field House, 6754 Valley View Road, Edina; enter door #6

Equipment

- Teams should bring a first aid kit and basketball to each game.
- Uniforms with a permanent number on the back are required.

Roster and Players

- All players must be 18 years of age.
- Rosters are due before the first game. Teams can have a maximum of 12 players on their roster.
- Players can be added to the roster until Jan 1, 2021.
- Edina resident teams must have 90% Edina residents. An individual living in or working full-time in Edina is considered a resident.
- Teams must have five players to start a game. If a team does not have enough players five minutes after scheduled game time, the game will result in a forfeit.
- If you need additional players please contact Tiffany Bushland at tbushland@EdinaMN.gov for a list of interested players.
- An individual cannot play on two teams within the same division.

COVID-19 Rules

- All current local and state guidelines for facilities and athletics must be followed. As local and state guidelines are updated, they take precedent over the following rules.
- If players or anyone in their family is feeling ill, has a fever or other COVID symptoms do not attend the game.

- All players and officials are encouraged to continue 6 feet social distancing when possible.
- All players, officials and spectators are encouraged to wear a mask or facial covering.
- Avoid shared equipment. No handshakes, team huddles or high fives.
- Spectators should be kept to a minimum.

General Rules

- The official rules of the league will be Minnesota State High School League Rules unless otherwise indicated in this document.
- Jump balls will be used to start games and overtime periods. On other jump ball situations, the ball will be awarded out of bounds on an alternating basis.
- All games will consist of two 20-minute running time halves. The last two minutes of each half are stop time. If a team is behind by 15 points in the second half running time will continue.
- If the score is tied at the end of regulation time, there will be a 3-minute overtime period. If the score remains tied there will be a final 2-minute overtime period. The final minute of each overtime is stop time.
- Each team is allowed three 30 second timeouts per game. No timeouts are allowed in overtime.
- All fouls are counted as team fouls.
- Free throws will be shot on the seventh team foul per half.
- Dunking is not allowed. Penalty is automatic ejection. Player is responsible for any damage caused to the backboard.
- If all referees are absent, managers should agree on referee and play the game.
- No protests are allowed, league is meant to have fun. Referee has authority over the game.

Playoff Information

- Each Edina league will have a single elimination playoff.
- Tie breaker analysis standings are first calculated using games back. If there is a tie after the initial calculation, the following tie breaker configurations will be used to break the tie or ties.
 - 1 Winning Percentage
 - 2 Head-To-Head
 - 3 Head-To-Head Differential
 - 4 Total Points For
 - 5 Total Points Against
 - 6 Total Points Differential
 - 7 Lowest Number of Forfeits
 - 8 Coin Toss

- Captains will be emailed if games are canceled by the league director before 4:30 p.m.
- Cancellations will be displayed on EdinaParks.com

Player Conduct

- Players will be removed from the game after committing two technical fouls.
- Alcohol is not allowed in Edina parks, schools, parking lots or surrounding streets.
- Smoking is not allowed in Edina parks, schools or parking lots.
