## ADULT WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL

### League Information

Adult Women's Volleyball is a recreational league. Team registration fee is \$300 per session. Matches will be played on Wednesday nights. Session one will start September 23 and end Dec. 16. Session two will start Jan. 6 and end March 17. There will not be any playoffs. Schedules and weekly standings will be posted on the City of Edina Parks & Recreation website. Registration deadline is Sept. 14 for fall session and Dec. 21 for winter session.

Edina High School Field House, 6754 Valley View Road, Edina; enter door #6

### Equipment

Each team is expected to supply a volleyball.

### Roster and Players

All players must be 18 years of age. Rosters are due before the first game. Players can be added to the roster by contacting Tiffany Bushland at [tbushland@EdinaMN.gov](mailto:tbushland@EdinaMN.gov). Teams must have four players to start a game. If a team does not have enough players, a five-minute grace period is given before the first game is forfeited. If a team does not have enough players after 15 minutes the entire match is a forfeit.

### COVID-19 Rules

- All current local and state guidelines for facilities and athletics must be followed. As local and state guidelines are updated, they take precedent over the following rules.
- If players or anyone in their family is feeling ill, has a fever or other COVID symptoms do not attend the game.
- All players and officials are encouraged to continue 6 feet social distancing when possible.
- All players, officials and spectators are encouraged to wear a mask or facial covering.
- Avoid shared equipment. No handshakes, team huddles or high fives.
- Spectators should be kept to a minimum.

### Miscellaneous

- Matches will be played according to USA Volleyball rules except for any adjustments listed below.
- A match will consist of three games to 25 points. Games are rally scoring, win by two, with a 27-point cap. Games are limited to 55 minutes. At the official's discretion, the third game may be played to 15 points with at 17-point cap as a result of time.
- A player may set the serve.
- An individual may not block or spike a serve.
- A player may play the ball below their knee.
- Underhand carries and overhand throws are rule infractions.
- Teams must rotate before the first serve.
- A player may touch or step on the center line when the ball is in play. If a player steps over the line it is a rule infraction.
