PURPOSE:

To establish a procedure to designate patrol zones for the Edina Police Department.

GENERAL STATEMENT

The City of Edina shall be divided into zones for the assignment of police officers on patrol duty.

480.02

BEAT/ZONE STRUCTURE

The following zone structure shall be in effect for all patrol shifts. The common zone boundaries shall be Highway 100 and Highway 62, bordered by the city limits.

Beat/Zone 1 - Northeast quadrant

Beat/Zone 2 - Southeast quadrant (primary car)

Beat/Zone 3 - Southeast quadrant (back-up car)

Beat/Zone 4 - Northwest quadrant

Beat/Zone 5 - Southwest quadrant

Beat/Zone 6 - East side patrol

Beat/Zone 7 - West side patrol

The duty supervisor shall assign zones based on calls for service, need for directed patrol, and available personnel.
